AFFIDAVIT
**DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE
OF AN INTOXICANT
T.C.A. 55-10-401**

Personally appeared before me, the undersigned, [Select one] X Commissioner ___ Metropolitan General Sessions Judge, the prosecutor named above and made oath in due form of law that [Select one] X he ___ she [Select one] X personally observed ___ has probable cause to believe that the defendant named above on 08/19/2012 in Davidson County, did unlawfully drive or was in physical control of any automobile or other motor driven vehicle while under the influence of any intoxicant, marijuana, narcotic drug, or drug producing stimulating effects on the central nervous system and that *the probable cause is as follows*: I was conducting stationary laser enforcement on 21st Ave S, when I observed the subjects vehicle traveling out bound on 21st Ave and appeared to be traveling over the posted speed limit of 30 mph. I confirmed with my laser unit that the subject's vehicle was traveling 45 mph (439.1 Feet). I pulled onto 21st Ave , activated my emergency equipment (lights and sirens) , and caught up with the subjects vehicle to conduct a traffic stop on the subjects vehicle for the traffic violation. The subject's vehicle continued to travel out bound on 21st Ave and passed by multiple shoulder areas she could have stopped at. When the subjects vehicle did respond to my emergency equipment, she stopped in the I 440 W entrance ramp lane of travel. Upon approaching and interacting with the subject I detected a strong odor coming from the interior of the vehicle that appeared to be the odor of an alcoholic beverage. I also observed she had red blood shot eyes, slurred speech and watery eyes. I asked her where she was coming from and she stated from her boyfriend's house. Then I asked her if she had consumed any alcoholic beverage to which she stated that she had consumed 3 beers prior to operating her vehicle. I had her exit the vehicle and continued to interact with her outside of the vehicle which I detected a strong odor coming from her expelled breath that appeared to be the odor of an alcoholic beverage. I administered the SFST's to the subject to determine her level of impairment, and I detected multiple indicators that she was impaired. I placed her under arrest for DUI and then read to her the Tennessee Implied Consent Law to which she stated that she understood it and had no questions. I then asked her if she would consent to a Breath Test to which she initially stated "No". I explained to her the consequences of refusing to take that Breath Test at which time she verbally stated that she would consent to take a Breath Test. After conducting the 21 minute observation period I administered the Breath Test and the BAC result was .160%
